

Draft your conclusion to “The Monkey’s Paw.”

Use your Alternate Ending Graphic Organizer to guide your writing.

A couple of things to keep in mind:

- I suggest you continue with the same “scary” tone. BUT if you decide to change the tone, you must have a smooth transition. You cannot jump from a scary tone directly into a happily ever after tone.
- The conclusion must be 1 ½ -3 pages.
- Type your homework. It must be double spaced, 12-point font, Times New Roman. By typing up your draft, you will have it saved on your computer for future changes.
- Include dialogue. If you are questioning how to write dialogue correctly, open your text book and see how any of the authors structure their dialogue. It will give you a clear example of where to put the quotation marks, commas, question marks, etc.
