- 2. Next, look up the most terrifying animal. Using descriptive language, and in 4 sentences, explain what this animal looks like, how it eats, how it cares for its young, how it can still be loved, how it is feared. You MUST save the link where you found the photo of the animal so you can show me and the class.
