
## **Mechanical Energy**

- 1) With what speed will it hit the floor?
- After hitting the floor the ball bounces back with speed 4 m/s.
- 2) What fraction of ball's mechanical energy was lost in the collision with the floor?
- 3) What maximal height will the ball reach after bouncing back?
- 4)\* Do any of the above answers depend on the mass of the ball?
